

License fees are made up of the following annual fees:

- Road and Bridge Fees 43-4-205 through 208 and 43-4-801 through 811 to the Department of Revenue for the Highway Users Tax Fund (created in the State Treasurer’s Office pursuant to 43-4-201)
  - 2000# and under \$25.75-\$29.00
  - 2001-5000 \$36.50-\$41.00
  - 5001-10,000 \$45.25-\$51.00
  - 10,001-16,000 \$58.75-\$66.00
  - 16,001 and over \$63.00-\$71.00
- Late Fees 42-3-103 and 42-3-112 – \$10.00 goes to the county, the remainder to the Department of Revenue for the Highway Users Tax Fund
  - \$10.00 for trailers
  - \$25.00 per month (up to \$100.00) for all other vehicles
- Emergency Medical Services 42-3-304 (21)- Distributed to Emergency Medical Services
  - \$2.00
- Motorist Insurance Identification fee 42-3-304(1)(a) to Department of Revenue to administer an insurance database
  - \$.50
- Peace Officer Standards and Training (POST) 42-3-304(24)
  - \$.60
- Add an additional amount to fees for age of vehicle 42-3-306(2) to the State Treasurer who credits the same to the Highway Users Tax Fund
  - Less than 7 years \$12.00
  - 7 to 10 years \$10.00
  - Over 10 years \$7.00
- Specific Ownership Tax (also known as Ownership Tax) 42-3-107 (8) is distributed according to the Board of County Commissioners Certification of Revenues and Levies (see distribution of ownership tax chart below)

Specific Ownership Tax portion of your vehicle registration is calculated based on the original taxable value (sticker price) of your vehicle. This ownership tax is a personal property tax, which is distributed to the various taxing entities in accordance with the mill levies that were established in the county. Although the taxable value will always stay the same, the percentage of tax charged is reduced as the vehicle ages.

To calculate ownership taxes refer to the table below.
