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Mesa County Clerk and Recorder's Offices Opening to the Public

Limited Exposure During Phase 2

Motor Vehicle:

- Phase 2 will begin Tuesday, May 26, 2020
- During Phase 2, the Main Motor Vehicle Office will remain open to the public with the same provisions as Phase 1 with some minor changes:
 - Hours of Operation: Monday through Friday from 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM
 - 8:00 AM to 9:00 AM will be reserved for residents of our vulnerable population
 - The last ticket will be issued at 5:00 PM
 - Transactions below are available:
 - New Titles
 - Bonds
 - Assigned VINS
 - Manufactured Homes
 - Initial Registrations
 - Plate Replacements
 - Persons with Disabilities (PWD)
 - Registration Renewals
 - Customers with registration renewals will not be given a ticket, but will be instructed when to enter the building
 - Customers are encouraged to utilize mail in, drop box, phone, kiosk, or online services to renew their tags
 - Customers must to adhere to social distancing guidelines and are asked of the following:
 - Wear a face covering
 - Wear gloves
 - Do not bring guests – one customer per ticket
 - Reasonable accommodations provided for elderly or nursing customers.

- Customers are urged to take advantage of the online services via mydmv.colorado.gov/ for renewals and PWD plus over 30 more e-services.
- Our Skip the Trip options are still available if customers wish to process their title and registration paperwork remotely. Packets are available for download via our website clerk.mesacounty.us/mv/quick-trip-tips/ or at our Main and Clifton Offices.
- There are two Renewal Kiosks in Mesa County that customers may utilize to renew their tags:
 - Mesa County Central Services Building located at 200 S Spruce Street
 - Clifton City Market located at 569 32 Road
- The Clifton Satellite Motor Vehicle office will re-open during Phase 2. This office will see the same services offered at our main office except for the following:
 - Hours of Operation: Monday through Friday from 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM
 - 8:00 AM to 9:00 AM will be reserved for residents of our vulnerable population
 - The last ticket will be issued at 4:30 PM
 - The transactions offered at the Main Motor Vehicle Office will be offered except for the following:
 - Manufactured Homes due to recording requirements
 - Registration Renewals will not have a renewal only line
 - Customers are encouraged to utilize mail in, drop box, phone, kiosk, or online services to renew their tags
- Phase 3: Upon direction from the Mesa County Public Health Department, Phase 3 will see the re-opening of the Fruita Office. All social distancing guidelines and services offered in Phase 2 will remain the same.
